It includes helpful information and resources, local events, tools to find a healthcare provider, and supports to help residents thrive.

Service listings have all the information you need about a service at your fingertips such as how to apply, eligibility, any fees, languages offered, the area it serves, accessibility, website links, and contact information.

How are listings added and updated?

Age-Friendly draws service information from the https://www.eriestclairhealthline.ca/ which follows strict policies, so you can trust the information that you find is accurate and up to date.

Ensure your service listing is up-to- date, remember to:

- Set reminders to review and update your organization's listings regularly.
- Verify that the contact information, eligibility criteria, hours and other key information are current.
- Make your service easier to find by including keywords clients may use in the search bar.
- Consider a separate listing from your main organizations' if the program or service has any of the following:
 - Different contact information
 - A separate location
 - Different eligibility criteria
 - Different hours


